Primary PE and Sports Premium Funding

For the academic year 2024 to 2025 the school will receive £18650 PE and Sport Premium Funding.

We must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of Physical Education on offer to pupils.

This means we will use the premium to:

1. To develop or add to the Physical Education already in place in school.
2. To make improvements now for future pupils

The 5 key indicators where improvements should be seen are:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity, aiming for 30 minutes a day within school time.
2. The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
5. Increased participation in competitive sport.

The National Curriculum aims are for all children:

1. To be physically active, working towards a target of 30 minutes' activity during and after the school day (excluding general play times).
2. To excel in a broad range of activities.
3. To engage in competition.
4. To lead healthy lifestyles.
