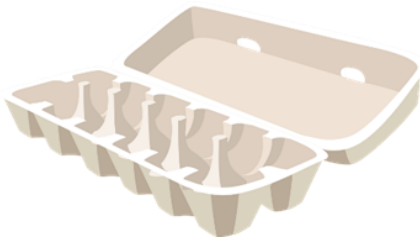


Design and Technology Home Project 2025
