

## Homework in Year 3 and 4

### Reading

Each child has been given a reading journal (yellow). Please can you use this to record when your child has read and how much. We recommend that each child reads every day for twenty minutes and at least twice a week with an adult. This journal needs to be kept in their book bags and brought in every day so that we can see how much they are reading and record when they have been read with 1-2-1 at school.

### Spelling

Each week the children will have a spelling focus and words stuck in in the front of their Homework book.

The children will have a selection of words to practise based in this spelling focus. Children should use the strategies (below) to practise these words.

The children are expected to write 1 sentence for each word. The sentence should be:

- Correctly punctuated.
- Neatly written (in cursive handwriting if they are joining).
- Interesting to read.

### Maths

In this book, your child will be given a piece of written maths homework to complete each week. This will reinforce what we have been doing in class this week. They are also expected to access Times Table Rockstars at least three times a week to practise their tables. They passwords are stuck in the front of the Homework book.

Homework books will be given out each Friday and should be returned to school by the following **Wednesday**.
